Arrival Delhi

- **About Delhi:-** Delhi, India's capital territory, is a massive metropolitan area in the country's north. In Old Delhi, a neighborhood dating to the 1600s, stands the imposing Mughal-era Red Fort, a symbol of India, and the sprawling Jama Masjid mosque, whose courtyard accommodates 25,000 people. Nearby is Chandni Chowk, a vibrant bazaar filled with food carts, sweets shops and spice stalls.
- **Overnight stay at Delhi Hotel.**

- **About Amritsar:-** Amritsar is a city in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab, 28 kilometers from the border with Pakistan. At the center of its walled old town, the gilded Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib) is the holiest gurdwara (religious complex) of the Sikh religion. It's at the end of a causeway, surrounded by the sacred Amrit Sarovar tank (lake), where pilgrims bathe.
- **Overnight stay at Amritsar Hotel.**

- Places to visit:- **Wagah (Atari) Border, Golden Temple, Jaliawala bagh, Durgiana Temple.**
- **Golden Temple:** The Golden Temple is spiritually the most significant shrine in Sikhism. It became a centre of the Singh Sabha Movement between 1883 and the 1920s, and the
- **Jaliyawala Bagh:** Jallianwala Bagh is a historic garden and memorial of national importance close to the Golden Temple complex in Amritsar, Punjab, India, preserved in the memory of those wounded and killed in the Jallianwala Bagh Massacre that took place on the site on the festival of Baisakhi Day, 13 April 1919
- **Durgiana Temple:** Durgiana Temple or Shri Durgiana Mandir is a Hindu temple situated in the city of Amritsar in Punjab, India.[1] Though a Hindu temple, its architecture is similar to the Sikh Harmandir Sahib (Golden Temple).[2] The temple derives its name from the Goddess Durga, the chief Goddess who is worshipped here. Murtis of Lakshmi and Vishnu are also located and worshipped in the temple.
- **Bagha Border:-** The lowering of the flags ceremony at the Attari–Wagah border is a daily Central Armed Police Force's practice that the security forces of India and Pakistan have jointly followed since 1959.
- Evening back to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Amritsar Hotel.**

Udaipur Sightseeing

- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for **Udaipur Sightseeing**
- Places to visit: **City Palace, Jagdish temple, Fateh Sagar Lake, Sahelion Ki Bari and Lok Kala Mandal.**
- **City Palace:** City Palace, Udaipur is a palace complex situated in the city of Udaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It was built over a period of nearly 400 years, with contributions from several rulers of the Mewar dynasty.
- **Jagdish Temple:** Jagdish Temple is a large Hindu temple in the middle of Udaipur in Rajasthan, just outside the royal palace. It has been in continuous worship since 1651.
- **Fateh Sagar Lake:** Fateh Sagar Lake is situated in the city of Udaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It is an artificial lake named after Maharana Fateh Singh of Udaipur.
- **Sahelion Ki Bari :**Saheliyon-ki-Bari is a major garden and a popular tourist space in Udaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It lies in the northern part of the city and has fountains and kiosks, a lotus pool and marble elephants. It was built by Rana Sangram Singh.
- **Lok Kala Mandal:** Bharatiya Lok Kala Mandal is a museum based in Udaipur in Rajasthan state in India engaged in studying folk art, culture, songs and festivals of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh and to popularise and propagate folk arts, folk dances and folk literature.
- **After visit back to the hotel and rest.**

Udaipur – Varanasi (By Flight)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave Udaipur airport to catch a flight to Varanasi.
- Reach Varanasi Airport pick up and smooth drive to Varanasi Hotel.
- **About Varanasi** -Varanasi is a city in the northern Indian state of Uttar Pradesh dating to the 11th century B.C. Regarded as the spiritual capital of India, the city draws Hindu pilgrims who bathe in the Ganges River's sacred waters and perform funeral rites. Along the city's winding streets are some 2,000 temples, including Kashi Vishwanath, the "Golden Temple," dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva.
- Check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Evening enjoy Ganaga Arti.**
- **Overnight stay at Varanasi Hotel.**

Varanasi Sightseeing – Prayagraj (02-03 Hrs)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel and leave for Varanasi Sightseeing.
- **Places to visit:-**
- **Kashi Vishwanath:** Kashi Vishvanath Temple is one of the most famous Hindu temples de dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is located in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, India. The temple stands on the western bank of the holy river Ganga, and is one of the twelve Jyotirlingas, the holiest of Shiva temples.
- **Bharat Mata Temple:** Bharat Mata Mandir Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, is located in the premises of Kashi Vidyapeeth, and is one of the most visited tourist places of Varanasi.
- **Sankat Mochan Temple:** Sankat Mochan Hanuman Temple is a Hindu temple in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, India and is dedicated to the Hindu God Hanuman. The temple was established by famous Hindu preacher and poet saint Sri Goswami Tulsidas in the early 16th century and is situated on the banks of the Assi river.
- Later drive to Prayagraj.
- Check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Prayagraj Hotel.**

08

Prayagraj Sightseeing

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for **Prayagraj Sightseeing.**
- **Places to visit – Prayagraj- Triveni Sangam , Khusro Bagh , Anand Bhavan , Allahabad Museum , Jawahar Planetarium ,Allahabad Fort.**
- **Triveni Sangam:** Pilgrimage place at the point where the Ganges & Yamuna rivers meet, home of a major Hindu festival.
- **Khusro Bagh:** Khusro Bagh is a large walled garden and burial complex located in muhalla Khuldabad, close to the Prayagraj Junction railway station, in Prayagraj, India. It is roughly 6 km from the Akbar fort. It is situated over forty acres and shaped like a quadrangle. It is listed as an Indian Site of National Importanc.
- **Anand Bhavan:** The Anand Bhavan is a historic house museum in Prayagraj, India, focusing on the Nehru family. It was bought by Indian political leader Motilal Nehru in the 1930s to serve as the residence of the Nehru.
- **Allahabad Museum:** The Allahabad Museum is a national-level museum in Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh. Established in 1931, it is known for its rich collection and unique objects of art, and is funded by Ministry of Culture.
- **Jawahar Planetarium:** The Jawahar Planetarium is located in the city of Prayagraj in Uttar Pradesh, India. It was built in 1979 and is situated beside Anand Bhavan, the former residence of the Nehru-Gandhi family, and now a museum.

- **Allahabad Fort:** Allahabad Fort was built by the Mughal emperor Akbar at Prayagraj in 1583. The fort stands on the banks of the Yamuna, near its confluence with the Ganges. It is classified by the Archaeological Survey of India as a monument of national importance.
- Evening back to hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Prayagraj Hotel.**

09

Prayagraj – Ayodhya (04-05 Hrs)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel and leave for Ayodhya.
- **About Ayodhya:** Ayodhya is a city situated on the banks of the Sarayu river in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. It is the administrative headquarters of the Ayodhya district as well as the Ayodhya division of Uttar Pradesh, India.
- **Places to Visit:**
- **Ram Mandir:** The Ram Mandir is a Hindu temple that is being built in Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh, India, at the site of Ram Janmabhoomi, the hypothesized birthplace of Rama, a principal deity of Hinduism. The temple construction is being supervised by the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra.
- **Hanuman Garhi:** Hanuman Garhi in Ayodhya is located on the right hand side bank of River Saryu. One of the prominent tourist attractions in Ayodhya, Hanuman Garhi, a huge four sided structure resembling a fort, is a citadel where a temple of Lord Hanuman is situated. The garhi has circular bastions on each of its comers.
- Check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Ayodhya hotel.**

- Places to visit:- **India Gate, Parliament House, Qutub Minar, Lotus Temple.**
- **India Gate:** The India Gate is a war memorial located near the Rajpath on the eastern edge of the "ceremonial axis" of New Delhi.
- **Qutub Minar:** The Qutb Minar, also spelled Qutub Minar and Qutab Minar, is a minaret and victory tower comprising the Qutb complex, which lies at the site of Delhi's oldest fortified city, Lal Kot, founded by the Tomar Rajputs. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site in the Mehrauli area of South Delhi, India.
- **Lotus Temple:** The Lotus Temple is a Bahá'í House of Worship located in New Delhi, India. It was completed in December 1986. Notable for its lotus-like shape, it has become a prominent attraction in the city. Like all Bahá'í Houses of Worship, the Lotus Temple is open to all, regardless of religion or any other qualification.
