Nearby is Chandni Chowk, a vibrant bazaar filled with food carts, sweets shops and spice stalls.

At the center of its stately street grid (notable in India) stands the opulent, colonnaded City Palace complex. With gardens, courtyards and museums, part of it is still a royal residence

- **About Mathura :** Mathura is a sacred city in Uttar Pradesh, northern India. The deity Lord Krishna is said to have been born on the site of Sri Krishna Janma Bhoomi, a Hindu temple. Dotting the Yamuna River are 25 ghats (flights of steps down to the water), of which Vishram Ghat is considered the holiest. Sati Burj is a 16th-century memorial tower. Dwarkadhish Temple has a carved entrance and a black-marble idol of Lord Krishna.
- **Places to Visit :** Mathura, Vrindavan.
- **After Sightseeing drive to Delhi**
- **Reach Delhi check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Delhi Hotel**

07

Delhi - Haridwar (By Car 4-5hrs)

Haridwar – Shimla (6+7hrs by car)

- **About Shimla:-** Shimla is the capital of the northern Indian state of Himachal Pradesh, in the Himalayan foothills. Once the summer capital of British India, it remains the terminus of the narrow-gauge Kalka-Shimla Railway, completed in 1903. It's also known for the handicraft shops that line The Mall, a pedestrian avenue, as well as the Lakkar Bazaar, a market specializing in wooden toys and crafts
- Evening reach Shimla, check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Shimla Hotel.**

Shimla local sightseeing & Kufri

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for Kufri tour and Shimla Local Sightseeing.
- After fresh n up leave to Kufri sightseeing. which passes through the splendid Hasan Valley and is known for its scenic beauty and pleasant weather.
- Visit the Himalayan Zoo which is home to wildlife like Felines, Antelopes, and other birds including Monal, the state bird of Himachal Pradesh
- **Places to visit:-** Shimla –Mall road, ridge, lakkar bazaar, scandal point, Advance Study, state museum, Jakhu Temple.
- **Overnight stay at Shimla Hotel.**

Shimla – Manali (6-7hrs by car)

- Have breakfast at restaurant & drive to Manali.
- On the visit **Sundernagar lake, Pandoh Dam.**
- **Places to Visit in Kullu:** Kullu Shawl Factory and Rafting & Paragliding (by own)

Manali –Solang Valley – Manali

It is a side valley at the top of the Kullu Valley in Himachal Pradesh, India 14 km northwest of the resort town Manali on the way to Rohtang Pass, and is known for its summer and winter sport conditions. **Solang Valley, famous for Nature beauty and snow activities in winter**

- **Overnight stay at Manali Hotel.**

Manali –Naggar –Manali Sightseeing

Ayodhya Sightseeing – Prayagraj (3-4hrs by car)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel and leave for **Ayodhya sightseeing**
- **Places to Visit:**
- **Ram Mandir:** The Ram Mandir is a Hindu temple that is being built in Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh, India, at the site of Ram Janmabhoomi, the hypothesized birthplace of Rama, a principal deity of Hinduism. The temple construction is being supervised by the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra.
- **Hanuman Garahi:** Hanuman Garhi in Ayodhya is located on the right hand side bank of River Saryu. One of the prominent tourist attractions in Ayodhya, Hanuman Garhi, a huge four sided structure resembling a fort, is a citadel where a temple of Lord Hanuman is situated. The garhi has circular bastions on each of its comers.
- **About Lucknow:** Lucknow, a large city in northern India, is the capital of the state of Uttar Pradesh. Toward its center is Rumi Darwaza, a Mughal gateway. Nearby, the 18th-century Bara Imambara shrine has a huge arched hall. Upstairs, Bhool Bhulaiya is a maze of narrow tunnels with city views from its upper balconies. Close by, the grand Victorian Husainabad Clock Tower was built as a victory column in 1881.
- **After sightseeing drive to Prayagraj, check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **About Prayagraj:-** Allahabad, officially known as Prayagraj, also known as Ilahabad, is a metropolis in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. It is the administrative headquarters of the Allahabad district—the most populous district in the state and 13th most populous district in India—and the Allahabad division
- **Overnight stay at Prayagraj hotel.**

Day
20

Prayagraj Sightseeing- Varanasi (2-3hrs by car)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel and leave for Prayagraj sightseeing.
- **Places to visit:- Anand Bhavan-** the former residence of Nehru family which has now been transformed into a museum showcasing various artifacts and articles of the era of Independence movement in India. **Allahabad fort-** It was built by Emperor Akbar in 1583. The fort stands on the banks of the Yamuna near the confluence with the river Ganges. It is the largest fort built by Akbar. **Laying Hanuman Temple-** The shrine is an underground pit which houses an enormous image of Lord Hanuman in a lying position.
- After sightseeing drive to Varanasi. En route visit **Sithamarhi -where Sita went into the earth.**
- **Check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Varanasi Hotel.**

Day
21

Varanasi Sightseeing

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for **Varanasi sightseeing.**
- **Places to visit:-**
- **Kashi Vishwanath:** Kashi Vishvanath Temple is one of the most famous Hindu temples de dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is located in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, India. The temple stands on the western bank of the holy river Ganga, and is one of the twelve Jyotirlingas, the holiest of Shiva temples.
- **Bharat Mata Temple:** Bharat Mata Mandir Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, is located in the premises of Kashi Vidyapeeth, and is one of the most visited tourist places of Varanasi.
- **Sankat Mochan Temple:** Sankat Mochan Hanuman Temple is a Hindu temple in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, India and is dedicated to the Hindu God Hanuman. The temple was established by famous Hindu preacher and poet saint Sri Goswami Tulsidas in the early 16th century and is situated on the banks of the Assi river.
- **Later drive back to the hotel.**
- **Evening enjoy Ganaga Arti.**
- **Overnight stay at Varanasi Hotel.**

Day
22

Varanasi – Mumbai (By Flight) (Vehicle for Airport Transfer)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel and drive to Varanasi Airport to catch the flight to Mumbai
- **Reach Mumbai, check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Mumbai hotel.**

Day
23

Mumbai Sightseeing (Day Free / No Vehicle) below tour Own Cost

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for Mumbai Sightseeing
- Today we take a City tour of Mumbai visiting Gateway of India, the entrance to the port of Mumbai. It was built to commemorate the visit of King George V in 1911. Across the road we visit Prince Wales Museum; It boasts a collection of ancient Indus Valley artefacts dating 2000 BC, plus some priceless Tibetan & Nepali Art.
- Later we take the boat cruise from Gateway of India to visit Elephanta Caves, houses rock cut temples dating back to 5th century CE. It was named by the Portuguese, after the statue of an elephant near the landing area of the island. We also drive through the Marine Drive, which runs along the shore of the Arabian Sea from Nariman Point past Chowpatty Beach to the foot of Malabar Hill. **(Elephanta tickets will be direct)**
- **Overnight stay at Mumbai Hotel.**

Day
24

Mumbai Sightseeing (Day Free / No Vehicle) below tour Own Cost

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for Mumbai Sightseeing
- Post breakfast around 1000 Hrs we go on to explore local market of Mumbai.
- We visit Crawford Market is one of the prominent markets of Mumbai. Though it is now officially known as the Mahatma Jyotirao Phule Market, it is still popular by its former name. The construction of the market building was completed in 1869. One of the main features of the building is the Clock Tower, which is adorned with beautiful Victorian carvings. Crawford market is a shopper's paradise. The market place is seen loaded with piles of fresh fruits and vegetables, the fragrance of which can be smelled from a distance. Besides, one can also grab some fresh cheese and chocolate here, to pamper his taste buds. Moreover, it is also known for its meat and poultry stalls, which provide a wide variety to the customers at reasonable rates. Thus, Crawford market is a must visit place on your trip to Mumbai, the city of dreams.
- Later we continue to visit Dhobi Ghat, A unique feature of Mumbai, the dhobi is a traditional laundryman, who will collect your dirty linen, wash it, and return it neatly pressed to your doorstep. All for a pittance. The "laundries" are called "Ghats": row upon row of concrete wash pens, each fitted with its own flogging stone. The clothes are soaked in sudsy water, thrashed on the flogging stones, then tossed into huge vats of boiling starch and hung out to dry. Next they are ironed and piled into neat bundles. The most famous of these Dhobi Ghats is at Saat Rasta near Mahalaxmi Station where almost two hundred dhobis and their families work together in what has always been a hereditary occupation.
- **Overnight stay at Mumbai Hotel.**

25
