### Arrival Bangalore)

- **About Bangalore:** Bengaluru (also called Bangalore) is the capital of India's southern Karnataka state. The center of India's high-tech industry, the city is also known for its parks and nightlife. By Cubbon Park, Vidhana Soudha is a Neo-Dravidian legislative building. Former royal residences include 19th-century Bangalore Palace, modeled after England's Windsor Castle, and Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace, an 18th-century teak structure.
- **After sightseeing back to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Bangalore hotel.**

### Bangalore - Mysore (145 kms / 03 hrs)

- **Visit to places:** Vidhan Soudha, the Nandi Temple(SRI BIG BULL TEMPLE, Bull Temple), the Lal Bagh Garden(Lalbagh Botanical Garden) and ISKCON Temple and Sri Radha Krishna-Chandra Temple.
- After Sightseeing leave for Mysore.
- **About Mysore:** Mysore (or Mysuru), a city in India's southwestern Karnataka state, was the capital of the Kingdom of Mysore from 1399 to 1947. In its center is opulent Mysore Palace, seat of the former ruling Wodeyar dynasty. The palace blends Hindu, Islamic, Gothic and Rajput styles. Mysore is also home to the centuries-old Devaraja Market, filled with spices, silk and sandalwood.
- **Reach Mysore check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Mysore hotel.**

### Mysore - Coorg (110 / 03 hrs)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.  
Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for **Mysore sightseeing.**
- **Visit to places:** Chamundeshwarari temple and Brindavan Gardens.
- After sightseeing leave for Coorg.
- **About Coorg:** Kodagu, also known as Coorg, is a rural district in the southwest Indian state of Karnataka. In the area's north, Madikeri Fort has 2 life-size elephant statues at its entrance, plus a Gothic-style church with a museum on its grounds. Nearby, the Hindu Omkareshwara Temple dates back to the 19th century. Farther north are the domed Raja's Tomb, a burial place of Kodava kings, and cascading Abbi Fall.
- **Check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Coorg hotel.**

### Coorg (Madikeri) city tour

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for **Coorg Sightseeing.**
- **Visit to Places:** Abbey Falls, Raja's Seat, Omkareshwara Temple, Madikeri Fort .
- **After Sightseeing back to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Coorg Hotel.**

### Coorg - Ooty (225 hrs / 06 hrs)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for **Ooty.**
- **About Ooty:** Ooty (short for Udhagamandalam) is a resort town in the Western Ghats mountains, in southern India's Tamil Nadu state. Founded as a British Raj summer resort, it retains a working steam railway line. Other reminders of its colonial past include Stone House, a 19th-century residence, and the circa-1829 St. Stephen's Church. Its 55-acre Government Botanical Garden lies on the slopes of Doddabetta Peak.
- **Reach Ooty check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Ooty hotel.**

### Ooty Sightseeing

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for **Ooty Sightseeing.**
- **Coonoor** - Located around 20 km from Ooty Coonoor is one of the largest hill stations after Ooty. In the Nilgiri Hills, at an altitude of 1,850 m above sea level, this hill stations presents alluring list of tourist attractions and adventure sports like trekking.
- **Sim's Park** - Located at a height of 1780 meters, Sim's Park is a botanical garden which was established in 1874. It has more than 1000 species of flora including Queensland Karry Pine, Rudraksha (the bead tree) and Ornamental tree making it a place worth visiting.

- **Lamb's Rock** - Located on the way to Dolphin's Nose in Ooty, Lamb's Rock is also called as Echo Rock. A popular picnic spot, it offers an admirable view of Coimbatore Plains and surrounding lush greenery. Route to this place offers trekking opportunities too.
- **Dolphin's Nose** - Located 10 km at a distance from Coonoor, Dolphin's Nose is a peak offering enchanting view of the Nilgiri Hills and the Catherine Falls. The peak of the hills resembles a nose of a dolphin hence the name.
- **Tea Garden** - Coonoor, known as the tea garden town, boasts of many breath taking tea gardens. A tour to these tea plantations, walking through the lush greenery and refreshing aromas of tea is an experience worth trying.
- **After sightseeing back to the hotel & rest**
- **Overnight stay at Ooty Hotel.**

### Ooty – Coimbatore

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for Coimbatore.
- **About Coimbatore** -Coimbatore is a city in the south Indian state of Tamil Nadu. To the northwest is the centuries-old, Dravidian-style Arulmigu Subramaniaswami Temple, Marudamalai. The colorful and intricately carved Arulmigu Patteeswarar Swamy Temple lies southeast of here. In the center, the Gass Forest Museum has a huge collection of preserved animals and tree trunks. Southeast, birds and butterflies inhabit Singanallur Lake.
- **Places to visit:** Gass Forest Museum, Coimbatore, VOC Park and Zoo, Coimbatore , Ukkadam-Valankulam Lake, Coimbatore .
- **Check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Coimbatore Hotel.**

### Coimbatore – Kodaikanal

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for Kodaikanal.
- **About Kodaikanal** :Kodaikanal is a hill town in the southern Indian state of Tamil Nadu. It's set in an area of granite cliffs, forested valleys, lakes, waterfalls and grassy hills. At 2,000 meters above sea level, the town centers around man-made, star-shaped Kodaikanal Lake, bordered by evergreen forest. Rowing boats can be hired, and hikers and cyclists follow the 5k Lake Road path around the shore.
- Evening visit to Cookers walk, Green valley view, and the Kodai Lake - Star Shaped Lake and Bryant Park.
- **Check in to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Kodaikanal Hotel.**

### Kodaikanal Sightseeing

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for Kodaikanal tour.
- **Places to visit:** visit Pillar's Rocks Silent Valley View, Berijam lake view, Silver cascade falls, Devil's Kitchen - popularly known as the Guna Caves, Pine Forest, Kurinji Andavar Temple.
- **Note:-** Berijam Lake View, we need to take permission prior to the entry. We will try to cover otherwise we will skip this sightseeing point.
- **After sightseeing back to the hotel and rest.**
- **Overnight stay at Kodaikanal Hotel.**

### Kodaikanal – Madurai

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for **Madurai**.

- **About Madurai:** Madurai is an energetic, ancient city on the Vaigai River in the South Indian state of Tamil Nadu. Its skyline is dominated by the 14 colorful gopurams (gateway towers) of Meenakshi Amman Temple. Covered in bright carvings of Hindu gods, the Dravidian-style temple is a major pilgrimage site. Millions attend the processions and ceremonies of April's Chithirai Festival celebrating Meenakshi and Lord Vishnu.
- Reach Madurai check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Madurai Hotel.**

### Madurai Sightseeing

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for Madurai.
- **Places to visit:** Madurai Meenakshi amman temple, Pudhu Mandapa - oldest of shopping arcades near Meenakshi Temple, Thirumalai Nayak Palace - blend of Dravidian and Islamic styles of architecture, Thiruparankundram - Lord Shiva and Lord Vishnu faces each other, and Gandhi Museum.
- Evening back to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Madurai Hotel.**

### Madurai – Rameshwaram

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for **Rameswaram**.
- **About Rameswaram:** Rameswaram is a town on Pamban Island, in the southeast Indian state of Tamil Nadu. It's known for Ramanathaswamy Temple, a Hindu pilgrimage site with ornate corridors, huge sculpted pillars and sacred water tanks. Devotees bathe in the waters of Agni Theertham, off the beach east of the temple. Gandamadana Parvatham is a hill with island views.
- Check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Rameshwaram Hotel.**

### Rameshwaram Sightseeing

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for Rameswaram tour.
- **Places to visit:** Rameshwaram Temple is one of the 12 Jyotirlingas in India. Legend says that Ramanatha Swamy Temple stands where Lord Rama performed worship of a Sand Lingam made by Sita. Other places of interest in Rameshwaram are Ramanathaswamy Temple, Dhanushkodi, Agnitheertham Gandamadana Parvatham etc.
- Evening back to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Rameshwaram hotel.**

### Rameshwaram – Kanyakumari (05-06 Hrs)

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for **Kanyakumari**.
- Reach Kanyakumari check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Kanyakumari Hotel.**

### Kanyakumari (Vivekanand Rock Temple) – Kovalam

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for **Kovalam**.
- **Visit to places:** The Arabian Sea, the Indian Ocean and the Bay of Bengal merge at Kanyakumari. It is an important pilgrimage center for Hindus.
- After sightseeing drive to Kovalam, check in to the hotel and rest.

- **Overnight stay at Kovalam Hotel.**

### **Kovalam / Trivendram – Alleppey**

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & check out from the hotel, leave for Alleppey.
- **Places to visit at Trivendram:** Kovalam Beach and SREE PADMANABHA SWAMY TEMPLE. The origin of the Temple of Sree Padmanabhaswamy is lost in antiquity
- After sightseeing drive to Alleppey, check in to the hotel and rest.
- **Overnight stay at Alleppey House Boat.**

### **Alleppey - Cochin -Goa (Flight) 09:55-15:40)**

- Very early check out from house boat and drive to Cochin flight to Goa. Arranged transfer by AC Tempo traveler at Goa to Hotel.
- Overnight stay at Goa Hotel

### **North Goa Tour**

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for North Goa Sightseeing.
- Start your tour by visiting Vagator Beach. This silver sandy beach overlooking the majestic Chapora Fort. Vagator Beach is one of the most beautiful beaches in Goa and here you can enjoy a refreshing swim or go exploring its beautiful stretch dotted with huge red cliffs and two fresh bubbling springs. Later, you will visit Anjuna Beach, which is renowned for its breathtaking and scenic beauty. The beautiful seashore is covered by uneven boulders that serve as a backdrop to many wonderful Goan rave parties. Watch the waves splash the boulders, bask in the laid-back bliss, or try out the watersports such as parasailing, yachting and windsurfing, and banana rides. Lastly, visit the Fort Aguada that is currently serving as the Central Jail. Fort Aguada is one of the largest as well as the best-preserved relic of the Portuguese era. Built in the early 17th century, the fort guarded the seaway entry into the River Mandovi and protect Old Goa from potential enemy attacks.
- After the sightseeing tour, return to the hotel.
- **Overnight stay at Goa Hotel.**

Day  
19

### **South Goa Tour**

- Morning wake up with new excitement, get relaxed & fresh n up.
- Have breakfast at restaurant & get ready for South Goa Sightseeing
- Proceed for the sightseeing tour of Old Goa, which is the heritage capital of Goa. Walk around the area and experience the world-famous Churches of St Francis Xavier, Se Cathedral, Basilica of Bom Jesus, Monuments of St Cajetan Church, St Catherine's Church, Tower of St. Augustine, and Nunnery/Convent of St. Monica.
- Many of these relics of the Portuguese colonial rule of Goa are listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Continue your sightseeing tour by visiting the old temples of Goa namely Shanta Durga Temple, Lord Mangueshi, an incarnation of Shiva, also known as the kuldevta of many Hindus in Goa especially of Saraswat Brahmins.
- After sightseeing, drive to the capital of Goa - Panjim city. Here you can enjoy a walk along the Latin Quarter of Goa, Mala Fontainhas, pay a visit to the State Museum and later see the pious Mary Immaculate church in City Square and end the day's excursion by exploring the markets of Panaji.
- In the evening, return to Hotel
- **Overnight stay at Goa Hotel.**
